Amcor's approach to sustainability recognises our Social Responsibility value; our Code of Conduct and Ethics Policy and the interests of our broad range of stakeholders. The Report outlines our efforts in our five domains of sustainability: economy, workplace, marketplace, environment, and community.

The Report also demonstrates how Amcor's sustainability risks and opportunities are identified, prioritized and managed, supporting Amcor's adherence to the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) Corporate Governance Council's Principles of Good Corporate Governance and Best Practice Recommendations – specifically Principle 7 (Recognise and Manage Risk).

The Report has been prepared in accordance with the Global Reporting Initiative's (GRI) Sustainability Reporting Guidelines (2006) and AccountAbility's AA1000 Assurance Standard (2008). NetBalance, one of the largest providers of sustainability advice, assurance, and research in Australia, has independently assessed the Report and confirmed that it meets the requirements for the B+ GRI Application Level.
